Standards for Members

Clark Middle School (CMS) Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS)

The National Junior Honor Society at Clark Middle School is an organization that promotes appropriate recognition for its students who reflect outstanding accomplishments in the areas of scholarship, character, service, and citizenship.

Members must maintain a **minimum cumulative** Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.33 to remain in NJHS.

All members must complete at least seven and a half (7.5) hours of approved community service per semester for a total of fifteen (15) hours. At least 4 of your total hours must be in-school. If you are unsure of what constitutes "approved" service, see the NJHS advisor, Mrs. Giannini, Room 511. Members should make a personal copy of the service hour form(s) turned in, in case a discrepancy may arise.

Dues are \$10.00 per year for all members and must be paid before induction into NJHS.

NJHS members are expected to maintain the highest standards of ethical and moral behavior. Members with minor disciplinary problems (i.e. use of profanity, unexcused absences, excessive tardies, etc.) may be placed on probation. **Members with flagrant disciplinary problems may be dismissed without warning (i.e. without probation).** These flagrant violations include, but are not limited to, the following: stealing; destruction of property; cheating; forging a note (misrepresentation); truancy; fighting; or possession, stealing, or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Members who fail to maintain the minimum GPA or fail to complete the service hours may be placed on probation and not recognized at the 8th Grade Awards Ceremony. Failure to correct any probation may result in dismissal. You cannot reapply or be reinstated into CMS NJHS if you are dismissed.

Members are responsible for seeking information concerning their status.

I understand the standards and responsibilities of membership of the Clark Middle School Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society. I also understand that failure to adhere to these standards will result in probation and possible dismissal from NJHS.
