ESSAY: Being selected to NJHS is an honor our faculty does not bestow lightly. **Please type a one-page essay single spaced. The committee will only read the first page.** Anything over one page will not be considered. The essay must fit on the sheet provided. If you go to Clark's Website>Academics>NJHS, you can type and print the essay directly on the application. The Faculty Committee will judge your essay following the Indiana Writing Standards. You must earn at least 3 points on a 4-point rubric to be admitted. The following is the criteria to earn 3 points:

Three points will be earned if there are only some minor errors in the following areas:

- Capitalization and punctuation are mostly correct.
- Most words are spelled correctly.
- Grammar and word usage are mostly correct.
- Paragraphing supports meaning.

Additionally, to earn a 3 there should be NO errors in the following areas:

- Appearance standards have been met (Single Spaced, 1-page maximum)
- Stays focused on task/topic.
- Includes thorough and complete ideas and information.
- Clearly addresses how they demonstrate leadership, character, service and citizenship.



Students inducted into the NJHS should excel in five areas. You have already demonstrated one area: scholarship. The other areas are leadership, character, service and citizenship. How so do you demonstrate excellence in these areas, and why does this make you a worthwhile candidate for membership into the Clark Chapter of NJHS?
